Project Description: This Project will reconstruct an existing cathodic protection well by installing a new 11-inch diameter, approximately 41-foot deep cathodic protection well in place in the City of San Rafael to improve cathodic protection of the water distribution system as part of the District’s Capital Improvement Program.

CEQA Exemption Status: Categorical Exemption Section 15302(c), Replacement or Reconstruction.

Reason for Exemption: This project qualifies for exemption pursuant to Section 15302(c) of the CEQA Guidelines inasmuch as it is the replacement of existing cathodic protection equipment involving negligible or no expansion of capacity.

Project Approval: The Marin Municipal Water District Board of Directors approved the award of a contract for project construction, which represents project approval as defined by Section 15352 of the Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act, at their regularly scheduled meeting on July 16, 2024.

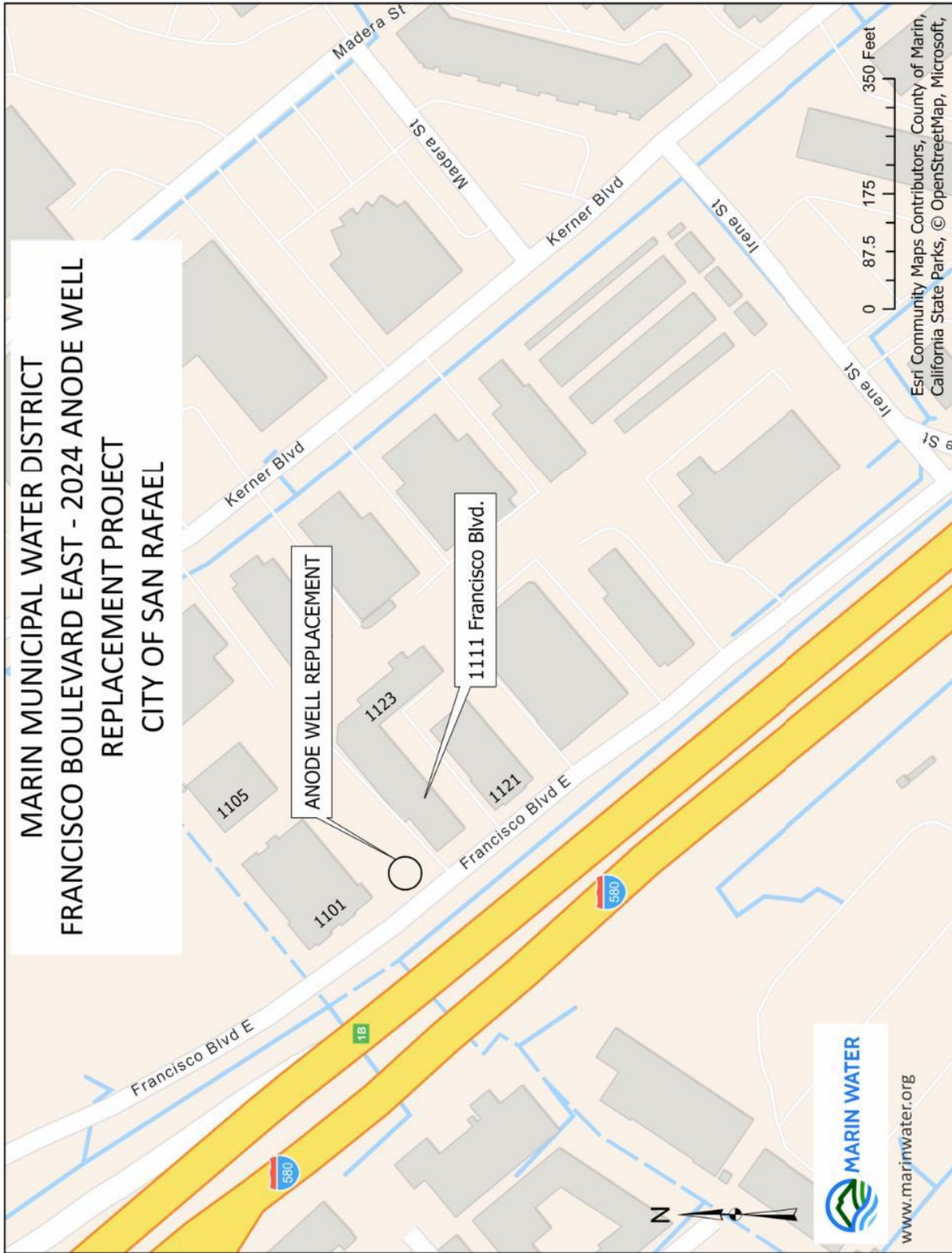
