<b>Subject:</b>	Liquor License Fees
<b>Background Information:</b>	<p>The Ways and Means Committee last met on February 8, 2022, to discuss liquor fees and provided directions to the City Clerk at the time to provide an updated fee recommendation later. With turnover and a re-arrangement of the Council Committee members the item had not been brought up.</p> <p>A table of cities of comparable size to Marshall is attached along with the average fee for each municipality. Included in the table are also a few regional cities to provide additional perspective.</p> <p>Liquor fees were last adjusted in 2018 to increase Brewer Tap Room from \$250 to \$500 and to lower On-Sale Liquor from \$4,200 to \$3,000.</p> <p>Staff recommend that Beer Off-Sale, Beer On-Sale and Temporary On-Sale licenses be increased to at least the average for a city our size.</p> <p>Minnesota Statute §340A.408 Subd. 3a does require a public hearing if liquor license fees were to increase for Beer on/off sale and on-sale intoxicating liquor. All license holders would receive notification at least 30 days before the hearing date along with the published notice in the Marshall Independent.</p>
