<b>Subject:</b>	City Event/Public Property Use Fees
<b>Background Information:</b>	<p>The number of requests to use public spaces that provide electrical outlets have increased and previously the city provided the power for private use at zero cost to participants at events. Events such as Sounds of Summer and Crazy Days only required permits to close off streets and electrical power was assumed to be provided at no additional charge. Visit Marshall requires a flat fee of \$100/day at the Red Baron Arena for electrical hook up and \$100/day for other events not located at the arena that Visit Marshall is involved with that require electricity. Community Services/Parks already has fees built into the fee schedule to address facilities that require additional power requirements, such as ballfields with or without lighting.</p> <p>Staff recommend a fee of \$100/day for events to be in line with Visit Marshall and Community Services/Parks.</p>
