<b>Subject:</b>	Consider Award of Proposal for Wastewater Sanitary Manhole Sealing and Relining Project.
<b>Background Information:</b>	The Wastewater Department has been annually relining some of the worst sanitary manholes that have become deteriorated due to age and hydrogen sulfide. These are in poor structural shape and leaking ground water into the sanitary system. We have found a relining system that is working very well and is much cheaper than replacing the manholes. Once relined, the manholes should have a life expectancy of 50 years again. Each year, an amount is budgeted to do several manholes out of the WWTF Equipment Repair & Maintenance line item.
<b>Fiscal Impact:</b>	Per the Finance Department, this project will be funded from Wastewater Equipment Repair & Maintenance (Account# 602-49500-53415). City staff would take care of traffic control on the project for a cost savings of \$6,500 for this item on the project.
<b>Alternative/ Variations:</b>	No alternative actions recommended.
<b>Recommendation:</b>	that the Council approve acceptance of the quote from Hiperline of Cokato, Minnesota, in the amount of \$65,809.00 for the above-referenced project sealing and relining nine manholes in 2021.
