Subject:	Project WW-001: Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation/Lining Project - Consider Authorization to Advertise for Bids
Background Information:	<p>City staff has identified numerous segments of public sewer main that would be good candidates for cured-in-place-pipe (CIPP) lining improvements. The CIPP method is trenchless, and good candidates are pipe segments that are not located in areas that are scheduled for reconstruction in the 10-15-year CIP. CIPP lining is considered a “structural lining”, which means the final product can bear the weight of the ground above the pipe on its own. The final product is watertight, very smooth (results in excellent flow characteristics), and structural.</p> <p>Sanitary sewer segments that will be lined are included in the attached maps. Locations include sewers on Elm Street, College Drive, Walnut Street, a location at the WWTF, and some backyard sewers in the Robert/Lawrence/Viking/Roosevelt neighborhoods.</p> <p>This item was presented to the Public Improvement/Transportation Committee on 10/02/2025. On 10/28/2025, City Council authorized staff to contract with Bolton & Menk, Inc. for project design.</p> <p>The project plans and specifications are now completed, and the project is ready to be advertised for bids. Staff is proposing to begin advertising the project on January 30th with a bid opening date of February 26, 2026. Staff would intend to bring a recommendation of award to the City Council on March 10, 2026.</p>
Fiscal Impact:	The engineer’s estimate from BMI, including contingencies and engineering costs is \$1,572,355. This project is currently identified in our CIP for \$1,600,000.
Alternative/ Variations:	No alternative actions recommended.
Recommendations:	that the City Council authorize the advertisement for bids for the above-referenced project.
