Background	As per the latest Governor Walz Executive Order, 20-99, City staff are putting forth
Information:	consideration to provide for additional funding for those establishments impacted by the Order.
	Staff are recommending that fund balance reserves in the amount of \$100,000 be directed to
	EDA to provide for a grant program that can bridge a business from the closure on November 20 <sup>th</sup> through December 18 <sup>th</sup> .
	The transfer is authorized under Minn. Stat. 471.85:
	<b>471.85 PROPERTY TRANSFER; PUBLIC CORPORATIONS.</b> Any county, city, town, or school district may transfer its personal property for a nominal or without consideration to another public corporation for public use when duly authorized by its governing body.
	The Attorney General's office has issued an opinion that personal property includes money.
	The City's CARES Act funds have been encumbered and are no longer available post November 15, 2020
	City EDA Director Lauren Deutz will provide background on a potential program and uses of the funds.
