

RESOLUTION NO. 26-036

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL APPROVING
MINNESOTA LAWS, 2026, CHAPTER 48, SECTION 16

WHEREAS, the 2026 regular session of the Minnesota Legislature passed, and the Governor signed, Minnesota Laws, 2026, Chapter 48, Section 16 (the "Special Law"), which authorizes the City of Marshall to issue an on-sale wine and malt liquor intoxicating liquor license to Southwest Minnesota Statute University, all in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 340A; and

WHEREAS, a license authorized by this section may be issued for space that is not compact and contiguous, provided that all the space is within the boundaries of the campus of Southwest Minnesota State University and is included in the description of the licensed premises on the approved license application.

WHEREAS, the license under this section authorizes sales on all days of the week to persons attending events at the Schwan Regional Event Center and the Recreation/Athletic Facility, subject to the hours and days of sale restrictions in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 340A, and any reasonable license conditions or restrictions imposed by the licensing authority

WHEREAS, the Special Law is effective upon approval of the City by resolution adopted by a majority vote of all members of the City Council and filing a certificate with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, all in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021, subdivisions 2 and 3; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that is in the best interest of the City and its residents to approve the Special Law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marshall that Minnesota Laws, 2026, Chapter 48, Section 16 is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City Clerk is hereby instructed to file with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota the appropriate certificate and a copy of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT City staff are authorized and directed to take all additional actions necessary to implement the Special Law.
