<u>Section 1</u>: City Code of Ordinances, Chapter 10, Section 10-22 is hereby amended in summary as follows:

Event organizers are to take steps to prohibit persons from entering a premise if intoxicating liquor or cannabinoid products are sold that are unauthorized by state statutes.

<u>Section 2</u>: It is hereby determined that publication of this Title and Summary Ordinance will clearly inform the public of the intent and effect of Ordinance No. 23-031.
