<b>Subject:</b>	Project PK-011 / SAP 139-090-006: C Street/Southview Drive Trail Project – Consider Authorization to Advertise for Bids
<b>Background Information:</b>	<p>City staff secured a Transportation Alternatives (TA--Federal) grant in 2020 in the amount of \$399,528 for the construction of this shared use path. In addition, City Engineering staff submitted for and received \$211,997 in 2025 Active Transportation (AT—State) grant funds.</p> <p>The project includes for the installation of a 10-FT wide concrete trail from C Street to Southview Drive that generally runs parallel with Progress Drive. The trail then extends to the east along the south side of Southview Drive as an 8-FT wide concrete trail, ending at the intersection of Southview Drive and US 59/Main Street. Lastly, an 8-FT extension leads from the trail to existing walk at the Southview Elementary School to provide a link to the front door of the school. A few project plan sheets are included in the packet that identify the path of the trail.</p> <p>The plans and specifications have been prepared by City staff for the above-referenced project. All easements are secured and numerous meetings have occurred between City staff and adjacent property owners.</p> <p>At the 03/25/2025 meeting, the Public Improvement/Transportation Committee unanimously approved the motion to recommend to Council approval of the plans and specifications and authorize City staff to advertise the project for bids.</p>
<b>Fiscal Impact:</b>	The City has \$399,528 in TA grant, and \$211,997 in AT grant funding for this project. The current cost estimate is \$599,438 in construction costs, and \$95,910 in engineering costs (not grant eligible). Additionally, city staff has requested to advance up to \$150,000 in Municipal State Aid funds to help cover engineering fees and project costs in excess of grant awards.
<b>Alternative/ Variations:</b>	No alternative actions recommended.
<b>Recommendations:</b>	that the City Council authorize the advertisement for bids for the above-referenced project.
