<b>Subject:</b>	Consider Approval to Declare 1994 Pierce Aerial Apparatus and Nozzles as Surplus
<b>Background Information:</b>	<p>In October 2022, the Marshall City Council approved the Marshall Fire Department's purchase of a new aerial apparatus for approximately \$1.47 million.</p> <p>The Marshall Fire Department recently received the new aerial unit which officially entered service June 16, 2025. This apparatus replaces the department's 1994 Pierce aerial truck.</p> <p>With the new unit now fully operational, the 1994 Pierce truck is no longer required for departmental operations.</p> <p>In addition to the aerial truck, five firefighting nozzles have also been identified as obsolete and no longer compatible with current department equipment. These nozzles are no longer in active service and are recommended for surplus.</p> <p>City staff recommend that the 1994 Pierce aerial truck and five nozzles be declared surplus equipment. This designation will enable the city to explore sale options, including auction, or sale through a certified surplus equipment vendor.</p>

<b>Recommendations:</b>	Staff recommend that the City Council approve Resolution 25- Declaring of the 1994 Pierce aerial truck and five nozzles as surplus equipment and authorizing City staff to proceed with sale process.
