Subject:	Consider a Temporary Extension of Alcohol License Area for The Gambler & Fuzzy's
Background Information:	In conjunction with the Shades of the Past Roll-In on May 1, 2025, the Marshall Downtown Business Association has requested to utilize a space on the closed portion of Main Street to serve drinks to patrons. The current alcohol license approved by the City and State of Minnesota is for on-sale intoxicating liquor. The license identifies the licensed area as 303 W. Main Street for The Gambler and 236 W. Main Street for Fuzzy's. The State does allow the City to allow for a temporary extension of the designated area if they are contiguous with the other areas of the license holder. The City has complete discretion of any approval or conditions that may be applied as determined necessary.
