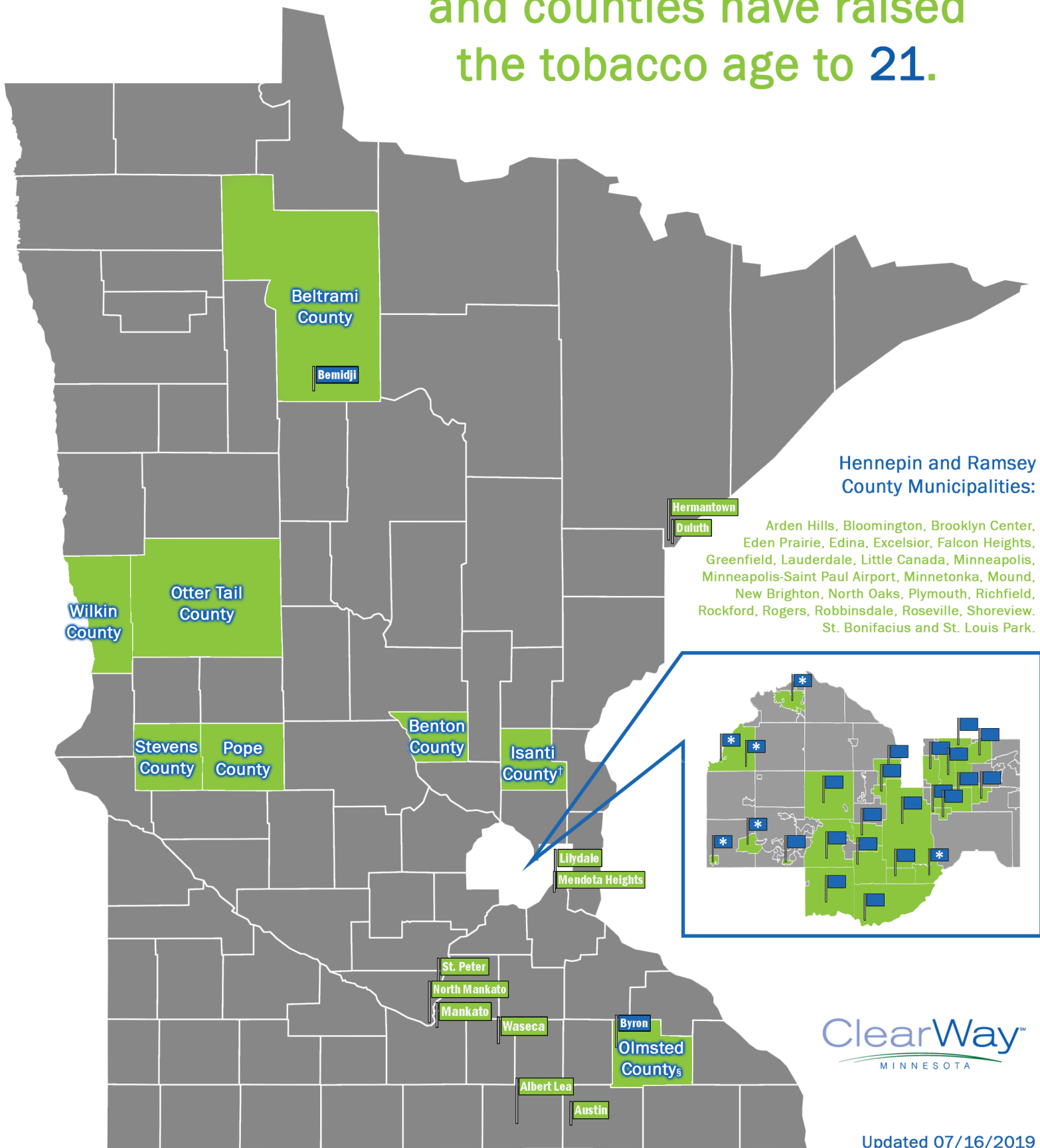


Tobacco 21 Policies in Minnesota
