Subject:	Adopt Resolution Supporting a Lyon County Regional Landfill Request for Legislative Funding for a Poly Fluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) Treatment Facility
Background Information:	<p>The city of Marshall has an industrial user agreement with Lyon County accepting Lyon County Regional Landfill leachate. Due to the leachate containing PFAS, Lyon County, the city of Marshall and the State of MN has a desire to eliminate these contaminants from our wastewater stream.</p> <p>Recently city and county representatives met to discuss PFAS in our waste streams. Lyon County has asked the city for support for their legislative request for funding of a PFAS Treatment Facility at the Lyon County Regional Landfill.</p> <p>In addition, the city to help achieve our goal with PFAS reduction in collaboration with the County, we have enlisted the services of our Coalition of Greater MN Cities government relations team.</p> <p>See attached fact sheet provided by Lyon County regarding PFAS at the Lyon County Regional Landfill and a fact sheet on PFAS provided by the MN Dept of Health.</p>
Fiscal Impact:	\$5.5 million requested from the State Legislature
Alternative/ Variations:	Delay could incur greater costs of remediation and implications for our wastewater permit.
