Subject:	Adoption of an Ordinance Amending Table 86-185 Sign Limitations under Section 86-185 District Regulations
Background Information:	<p>This is a minor change that will allow people to keep their small temporary signs longer than currently allowed. Generally, all temporary signs are limited to 14 consecutive days and 60 days total in a year. However, while discussing a specific situation, staff concluded that there is no harm in allowing people to keep a single small cardboard sign placed next to their houses for longer. Such signs may be favorite team recognition, dance club promotion, or even a political message.</p> <p>At its March 16, 2026, meeting, the Legislation and Ordinance committee reviewed this change and recommended approval.</p> <p>The Ordinance amending Table 86-185 Sign limitations was introduced at the March 24, 2026 Council meeting.</p> <p>The Planning Commission conducted a public hearing on April 8, 2026, and unanimously recommended approval</p>

Alternative/Variations:	None recommended.
Recommendations:	Planning Commission and staff recommend that the City Council adopt Ordinance 26-007, which is the ordinance amending Table 86-185 Sign limitations under Section 86-185 District Regulations.
