

SUMMARY ORDINANCE NUMBER 26-012

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 86, ARTICLE VI, DIVISION 4, SECTION 248 OUTSIDE STORAGE

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1: City Code of Ordinances, Chapter 86, Section 248 is amended in summary as follows:

If there is a standalone empty lot in a residential district no boats, trailers, campers, ect. may be stored unless the empty lot is next to an adjacent lot that is under the same ownership and there is a permitted use main building.

Section 2: It is hereby determined that publication of this Title and Summary Ordinance will clearly inform the public of the intent and effect of Ordinance No. 26-012.
