Subject:	Consider a Resolution Extending a Local Emergency Declaration
Background Information:	On March 24, 2019, Bob Byrnes, the Mayor of Marshall, acting on behalf of and for the City of Marshall, declared a state of emergency within the City of Marshall as per Minnesota Chapter 12. A declaration of a local emergency invokes necessary portions of the response and recovery aspects of applicable local or interjurisdictional disaster plans and may authorize aid and assistance under those plans. With this declaration the city's emergency organization structure, plan and EOC is activated. A Resolution must be enacted under authority of Minnesota Statutes Sections 12.29 and 12.37 to extend the period of a mayor-declared local emergency.
