Subject:	Contract with State of Minnesota and the City of Marshall for HAZMAT Services to Southwest Minnesota
Background Information:	For twenty-three years the City of Marshall has been committed to a professional and technical services contract with the State of Minnesota to provide regional HAZMAT response to a fourteen-county area through the Southwest Hazardous Materials Response Team. The current three-year agreement expires June 30 th , 2025. The State of Minnesota has asked if the City of Marshall and the Southwest Hazardous Material Response Team would continue providing the services outlined in the submitted Joint Powers Agreement effective July 1 st , 2025, and expiring June 30, 2027. The submitted agreement has increased the compensation awarded to the City of Marshall from \$60,000 to \$85,000 a year. Additional equipment, capital items and funding may be available to the City of Marshall throughout the term of the contract.
Fiscal Impact:	No matching funds required - \$255,000 awarded to the City of Marshall over a three-year Joint Powers Agreement.
Alternative/ Variations:	None
Recommendations:	Consider entering into an agreement with the State of Minnesota for the Marshall Fire Department to provide HAZMAT Response to Southwest Minnesota.
