Subject:	Consider approval of 2020 Workers Compensation Insurance
Background Information:	The premium for 2020 and estimated premium for 2021 are attached. The renewal is effective January 1, 2021 with the League of Minnesota Cities Insurance Trust.
	The workers compensation insurance covers City employees, elected and appointed officials, volunteer firefighters, all other volunteers, Library employees and Marshall Municipal Utilities employees. Staff recommends keeping the deductible at \$5,000. This will be an additional \$22,282 credit
	amount to the standard premium of \$297,089
	Manual Premium\$ 495,148Experience Mod. 0.60-198,059Standard Premium297,089Deductible Credit 6.50%- 22,282Premium Discount- 32,479Net Deposit Premium\$242,328This premium is paid by the following: City Portion\$198,413Library Portion\$2,567MMU Portion\$41,348This is a \$18,341 or 8.19% increase from 2020 to 2021.The experience modifier has decreased from 0.63 in 2020 to 0.60 in 2021. That would indicate that staff are continuing to keep a safe work environment as well as continued training for staff
	in safety at the workplace. The rate increase also reflects the upward trend in overall insurance costs. An excerpt from the League of Minnesota Cities has also been included in the attachments for further reference to the increase in insurance premiums.
Fiscal Impact:	The estimated annual 2021 premium for the city portion is \$198,413
