<b>Subject:</b>	Fire Department Scholarship
<b>Background Information:</b>	<p>A Marshall Fire Department Scholarship Trust Fund originated on December 31, 1997 with an anonymous donation of \$3,000. As of 12/31/2022, the Fire Department Trust Fund has a balance of \$16,910.00. In accordance with the administrative policy adopted by the City Council, the City Administrator or their designee has complete authority in awarding the scholarship. In 2009, the Ways and Means Committee was appointed by the City Administrator as the designee.</p> <p>Per Administrative Policy, Chapter 3, Sec. 1, scholarship awards must meet a minimum of \$100 a student. As of 12/31/2022 the total expendable funds are \$722.22.</p> <p>Additional expendable funds may be received between now and the scholarship award date.</p> <p>Applications must be received or postmarked no later than April 1, 2023 to be considered.</p>
