| Subject:                    | Adoption of Ordinance - amending Section 86-107 General industrial district   |
| Background<br>Information:  | The City has several areas outside of agricultural district that are used for agricultural activity.<br>Currently, such uses are not listed as a permitted use in any zoning district other than<br>Agricultural. However, it is reasonable that owners want to use open areas for some business<br>activity prior to eventually developing it; such business activity may include growing and<br>harvesting row crops on vacant land.<br>In light of the above, it makes sense to add growing row crops as a conditional use to I-2<br>general industrial district, since there are large open areas within I-2 district, and this kind of<br>activity – low labor and visitor intensive – does not contradict its objective. Staff would like to<br>have this ordinance changed before growing season starts in the spring; this change is not<br>related to the recently adopted Comprehensive Plan, so this section will have to be revised in<br>the future to align it with the Plan.<br>As a side note, there are some areas used for agricultural activities in the general business<br>district, but they will be dealt with differently. In order to avoid a CUP, which stays with the<br>property, we will utilize interim use permits issued for a year or two. All conditional and interim<br>use permits will come in front of the Planning Commission and the Council for approval.<br>The Planning Commission conducted a public hearing on April 10, 2024, and unanimously<br>recommended approval.<br>At its March 12, 2024, meeting, Legislation and Ordinance committee also reviewed this change |
|                             | and recommended approval.<br>The Ordinance Amending Section 86-107 General industrial district was introduced at the<br>April 23, 2024, City Council meeting.   |
