Subject:	Consider Approval of an Ordinance Amending Ch. 6 Article II-2 Intoxicating Liquor
Background Information:	<p>Since 1976 the City of Marshall had only allowed 5 types of establishments to possess a liquor license, which at the time were all the allowable types under State law:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hotels • Restaurants • Bowling centers • Clubs • Exclusive liquor stores <p>As new businesses came into existence and the want to expand retail liquor continued there are now 12 establishment types allowed to be issued an intoxicating liquor license by a municipality. Two of the allowable types not included in the draft ordinance are specific to the Minnesota Sports Facilities Authority and the Metropolitan Sports Commission.</p> <p>Staff had been approached by the Marshall A's about expanding their selection of beverages as the number of 3.2% Malt Liquor varieties were being reduced by local wholesalers. One of the allowable types being proposed includes summer collegiate league baseball teams, or a league established by the Minnesota Baseball Association.</p>
