Subject:	Consider Approval of an Ordinance Amending Ch. 6 Article II-2 Intoxicating Liquor
Background Information:	 Since 1976 the City of Marshall had only allowed 5 types of establishments to possess a liquo license, which at the time were all the allowable types under State law: Hotels Restaurants Bowling centers Clubs Exclusive liquor stores As new businesses came into existence and the want to expand retail liquor continued there are now 12 establishment types allowed to be issued an intoxicating liquor license by a municipality Two of the allowable types not included in the draft ordinance are specific to the Minnesota Sports Facilities Authority and the Metropolitan Sports Commission. Staff had been approached by the Marshall A's about expanding their selection of beverages at the number of 3.2% Malt Liquor varieties were being reduced by local wholesalers. One of the allowable types being proposed includes summer collegiate league baseball teams, or a league established by the Minnesota Baseball Association.
