Background Information:	On December 12, 2023, the City Council approved an agreement to contract with hearing officers to administer Chapter 2, Article VII, Section 2-410 Administrative Hearing Procedure of the city code. City Attorney Whitmore and the City Clerk sought out candidates to fulfill the role of hearing officers for the City of Marshall. The hearing officers will be considered public officers as defined by Minn. Stat. §609.415 and the hearing officer must not be a city employee.
