<b>Background Information:</b>	<p>On Tuesday, March 17, 2020, Mayor Robert Byrnes declared a state of emergency for the City of Marshall.</p> <p><b>12.29 DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY.</b> Subdivision 1. Authority to declare emergency. A local emergency may be declared only by the mayor of a municipality or the chair of a county board of commissioners or their legal successors. It may not be continued for a period in excess of three days except by or with the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision. Any order or proclamation declaring, continuing, or terminating a local emergency must be given prompt and general publicity and filed promptly by the chief of the local record-keeping agency of the political subdivision.</p>
