Subject:	Councilmembers and Mayor Salaries
Background Information:	In accordance with the City of Marshall Charter, Section 2.07 "Salaries of the Councilmembers and Mayor shall be discussed as an agenda item at the first council meeting in July of each year. After said discussions, the council shall set and determine said salaries in accordance with the applicable state law." <b>415.11 SECOND TO FOURTH CLASS CITIES; GOVERNING BODY SALARIES.</b>
	<b>Subdivision 1.Set by ordinance.</b> Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law, charter, or ordinance, the governing body of any statutory or home rule charter city of the second, third or fourth class may by ordinance fix their own salaries as members of such governing body, and the salary of the chief elected executive officer of such city, in such amount as they deem reasonable.
	<b>Subd. 2.After next election.</b> No change in salary shall take effect until after the next succeeding municipal election.
	<b>Subd. 3.Temporary reductions.</b> Notwithstanding subdivision 2 or a charter provision to the contrary, the governing body may enact an ordinance to take effect before the next succeeding municipal election that reduces the salaries of the members of the governing body. The ordinance shall be in effect for 12 months, unless another period of time is specified in the ordinance, after which the salary of the members reverts to the salary in effect immediately before the ordinance was enacted.

Recommendations:	To allow staff to review section 2.07 in the City Charter and section 2-53 in the City Code, to amend each section to more uniformly fit with State statute and provide a recommendation to the Charter Commission and Legislative and Ordinance Committee for action.
