Subject:	Adoption of Ordinance for Map Amendment (Rezone) at Various London Road Properties
Background Information:	This is a request by the City of Marshall to rezone the area as shown on the attached map from B-1 Limited Business District to R-4 Higher Density — Multi Family Residence District for potential future development of multi-unit residential building. The new Comprehensive Plan shows this entire area as Neighborhood Mix use with intent to allow for both commercial and residential uses. Rezoning procedures are described in Section 86-30 Amendments https://library.municode.com/mn/marshall/codes/code_of_ordinances?nodeld=PTIICOOR_CH86ZO_ARTIIADEN_DIV1GE_S86-30AM . Attached are the rezoned area extent for your reference. At the June 14, 2023, Planning Commission meeting, a public hearing was held, and a motion was made by Doom, seconded by Deutz to rezone the B-1 Limited Business District to R-4 Higher Density — Multi Family Residence District and leave the R-1 One Family Residence District strip along London Road as a buffer between the new R-4 Higher Density — Multi Family Residence District and the single-family homes on the other side of London Road. All voted in favor. The rezone was introduced at the City Council Meeting on June 27, 2023.

Alternative/ Variations:	None recommended.
Recommenda tions:	that the Council adopt Ordinance Number 23-018, to rezone area as shown on the map from B-1 Limited Business District and a narrow strip of R-1 One Family Residence District to R-4 Higher Density – Multi Family Residence District and leave the R-1 One Family Residence District strip along London Road as a buffer between the new R-4 Higher Density – Multi Family Residence District and the single-family homes on the other side of London Road.
