| Background <br> Information: | On January 25 <br> th, 2019, the Joint Law Enforcement Center Management Committee met to discuss <br> maintenance needs that require immediate attention by the committee. The two areas discussed <br> were related to the electronic security system and the air conditioning condenser and coil unit. Per <br> the Law Enforcement Joint Powers Agreement both Lyon County and the City of Marshall are <br> responsible for the common costs of operation which includes: repair, servicing, maintenance and <br> replacement of mechanical and electrical systems, roof repair and replacement, utility costs and <br> custodial and maintenance services. <br> The electronic security system that controls all access points to and inside the LEC started to fail in <br> January 2019. The inability to enter offices and exterior doors has affected the work environment <br> and created safety concerns for staff. Lyon County received cost proposals for repair or <br> replacement of the system. Brothers Fire and Security submitted the lowest proposal for <br> \$39,054.69 <br> The existing air conditioning condenser and coil are over 20 years old. Attempts have been made to <br> repair leaks and fix the controls on the existing unit. Maintenance staff and engineers have <br> determined the unit needs to be replaced in the spring of 2019. Lyon County received cost <br> proposals. Bisbee Plumbing \& Heating submitted the lowest proposal for \$63,900.00 |
| Fiscal Impact: | The total anticipated cost to replace both the electronic security system and the AC condenser and <br> coil is \$102,954.69. The City of Marshall's expected cost for these repairs is \$51, 477.35. These <br> expenses were not budgeted for in 2019. |
| Alternative/ <br> Variations: | None recommended. |
| Recommendations: | Approval to proceed with needed repairs as outlined above and payment of listed expenses per Law <br> Enforcement Joint Powers Agreement once work is completed. |
