On the shelves of “Books on 3rd Street” you’ll find fantasy, science fiction, poetry, memoirs, history, fiction, non-fiction and books for children.



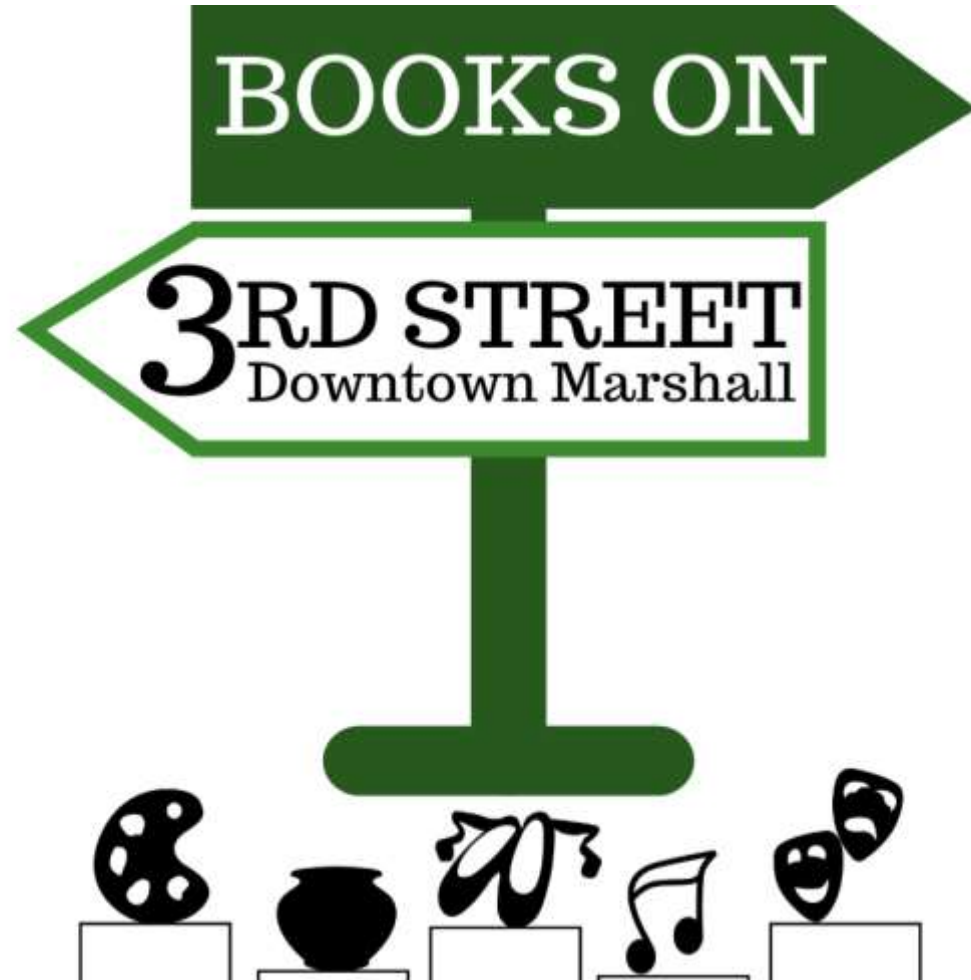

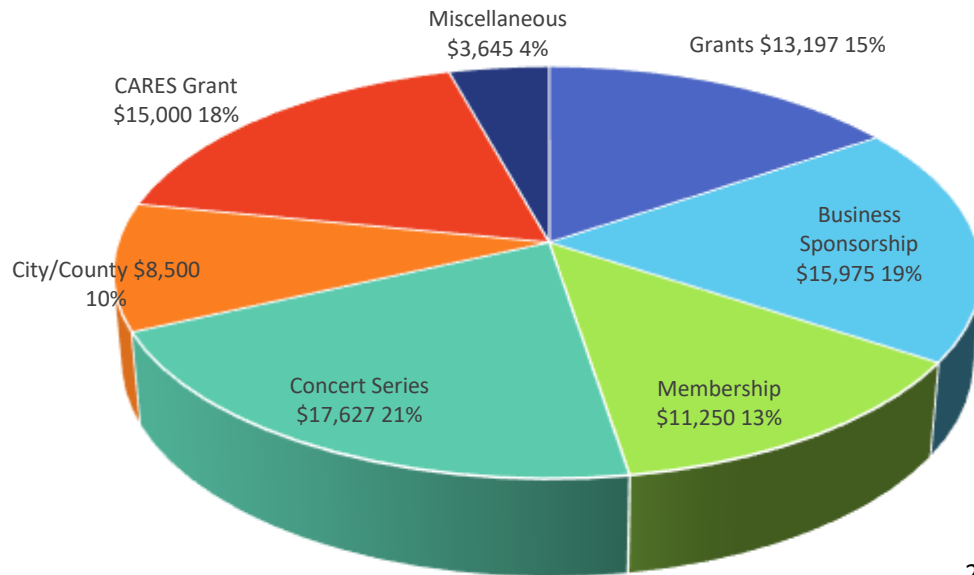

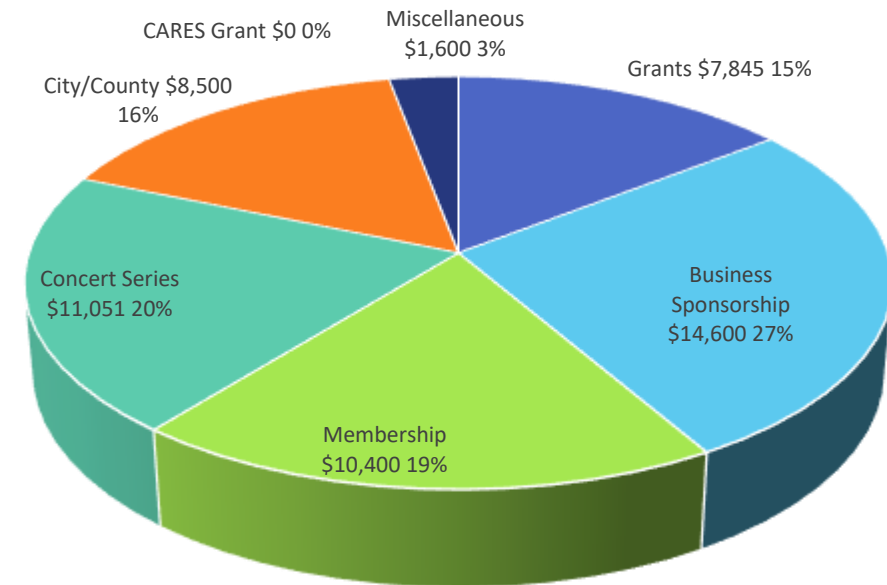

2020 Revenue



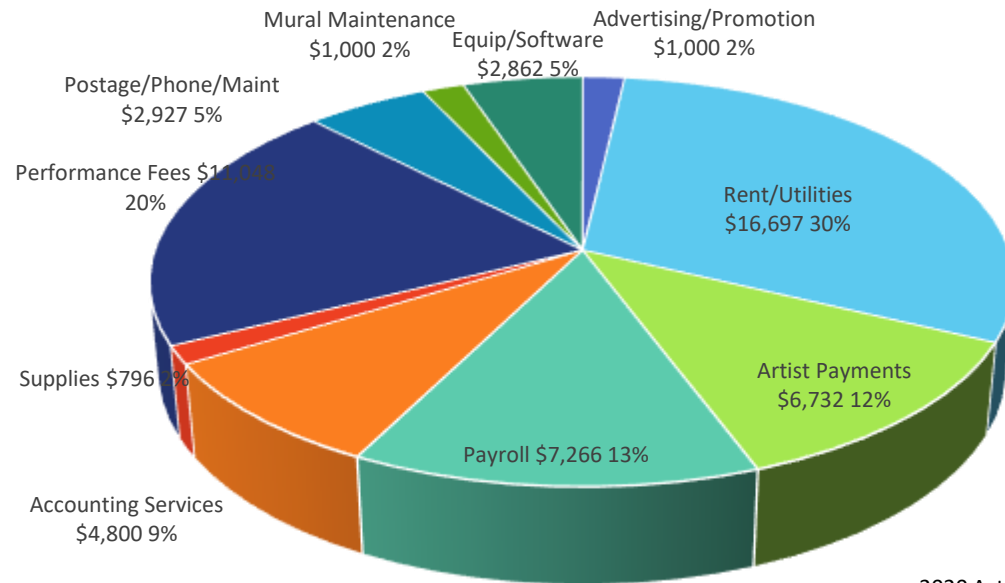
2021 Revenue Budget



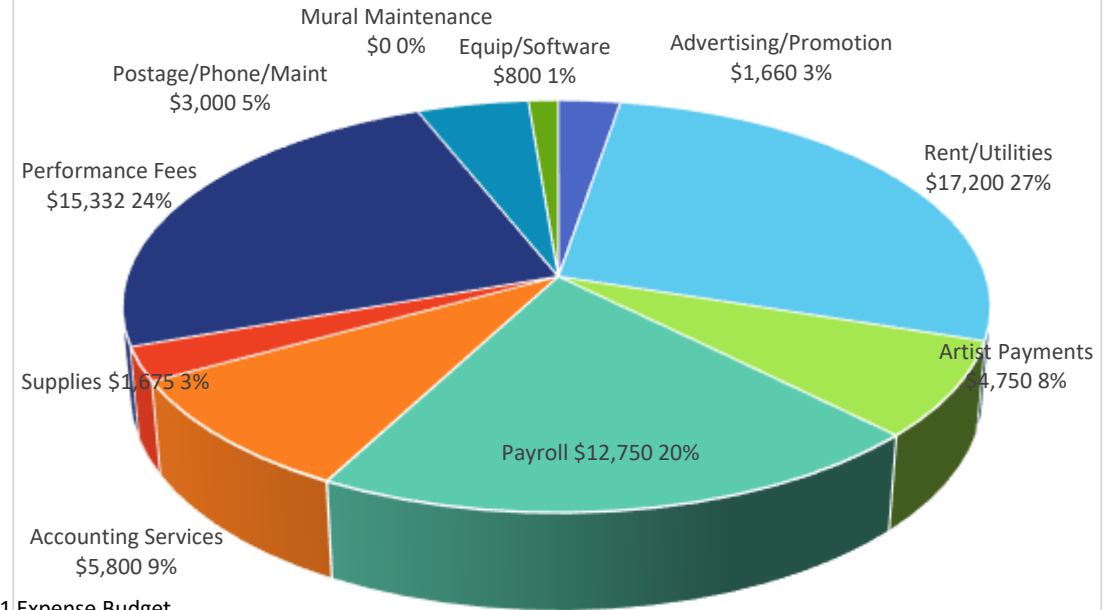
