Subject:	Resolution Number, Second Series, A Resolution Creating the 2020 City of Marshall Complete Count Committee
Background Information:	The U.S. Constitution (Article I, Section 2) mandates a headcount every 10 years, of everyone residing in the United States: in all 50 states, Puerto Rico, and the Island Areas. This includes people of all ages, races, ethnic groups, citizens, and noncitizens. The first census was conducted in 1790 and has been carried out every 10 years since then. The population totals from the 2020 census will determine the number of seats each state has in the House of Representatives. States also use the totals to redraw their legislative districts.
	Minnesota is once again at risk for losing a seat in the House of Representatives from 8 to 7. This would result in over 100,000 more Minnesotan's in each district.
	About \$675 billion is distributed to the state and local governments each year based of census data. In Fiscal Year 2016, \$15,459,175,947 was allocated to Minnesota to be distributed.
	Roughly, \$1,532 per person is allocated by the federal government to Minnesota or \$15,320 over a decade.
	Staff will create hybrid system of mayoral appointments and an application process to create our Complete Count Committee (CCC). The CCC will work throughout the entire City with focus on hard to count areas.
