<b>Subject:</b>	Ordinance Amending Chapter 74 Article VII Division 3-2 Permit for Class 2 All-Terrain Vehicles and Utility Task Vehicles 1) Public Hearing 2) Consider Adoption of an Ordinance Amending Chapter 74-VII, Division 3-2
<b>Background Information:</b>	<p>The City of Marshall currently allows the use of Class 2 All-Terrain Vehicles and Utility Task Vehicles to operate on public streets and roadways with a yearly permit. Both vehicle types are prohibited from driving on Minnesota Highways within city limits, which would include Main Street (Highway 59), College Drive (Highway 19), Highway 23 and Highway 68</p> <p>Proposed amendments would allow Golf Carts to operate on the same roads as ATVs/UTVs and would have the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Seatbelts for all occupants</li> <li>• Headlights</li> <li>• Taillight</li> <li>• Turn signals</li> <li>• Driver side mirror and passenger mirror/rearview mirror</li> <li>• Slow moving emblem</li> <li>• Restricted to streets with a posted speed limit of 30mph or less</li> </ul> <p>The permit process would mimic the current special vehicle application, and the fee would remain the same at \$35 per year.</p>
<b>Fiscal Impact:</b>	\$35/permit
