RESOLUTION RESTRICTING PARKING

WHEREAS, City Code, Section 7.03, 9.09, 9.14 providing for the installation of traffic control devices and signs and;

WHEREAS, It is in the interest of public safety and general welfare to provide necessary signs and traffic control devices and;

WHEREAS, The Common Council has reviewed the traffic conditions at the following referenced locations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That signs be installed restricting parking at the following location:

- 1) ON NORTH AND SOUTH SIDE OF MCLAUGHLIN DRIVE FROM STATE STREET EAST FROM 2 A.M. TO 6 A.M.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Engineer's Office and Public Works Department be in the same and hereby authorized to cause to be installed and/or remove such traffic control devices so as to conform to the above established provisions.

REGULAR MEETING - APRIL 5, 1993

Second Series, is a resolution restricting parking on the East Side of South 6th Street from Saratoga Street to the north property line of Lot 7, Block 7, original plat. All voted in favor of the motion.

Stunes moved, Edblom seconded, the adoption of RESOLUTION NUMBER 1556, SECOND SERIES, and that the reading of the same be waived. Resolution Number 1556, Second Series, is a resolution restricting parking on the West Side of South 6th Street from the South Right-of-Way Line of Lynd Street to the South Right-of-Way Line of South 7th Street. All voted in favor of the motion.

Hess moved, Stunes seconded, the adoption of RESOLUTION NUMBER 1557, SECOND SERIES, and that the reading of the same be waived. Resolution Number 1557, Second Series, is a resolution restricting parking on the North and South Side of McLaughlin Drive from State Street East from 2 A.M. to 6 A.M. All voted in favor of the motion.

Duane Aden, City Administrator, reviewed with the council an application for the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency to provide affordable mortgages for low to moderate income families. The request is for \$800,000 which would be for approximately 12 mortgages. Stores moved, Roggeman seconded, the proper city personnel be authorized to execute a request for mortgage funds under the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency. Under this program qualified buyers would be able to obtain affordable mortgage with favorable interest rates and terms. The mortgages would be purchased by the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency and funded through their bonding program. Proper city personnel were authorized to make a refundable deposit of \$8,000 to support the \$800,000 request. All voted in favor of the motion.

Upon the recommendation of City Engineer Rich Victor, Hess moved, Roggeman seconded, the proper city personnel be authorized to execute an amendment to the Engineering Agreement between RCM (Rieke, Carroll, Muller) and the City of Marshall for engineering services in relationship to the lift station and force main design for the Southside Trunk Sewer Project. The original agreement provided for a cost not to exceed \$70,500. The amended contract would not exceed \$88,000. As the design progressed additional mechanical, electrical, structural and architectural services were required in providing for a standby generator for this lift station. It was also necessary to move the proposed lift station site to a different area which created additional drafting work and rewriting the specifications. All voted in favor of the motion except Byrnes who voted no.

Roggeman moved, Stunes seconded, be it resolved that the proper city personnel be authorized to advise the State of Minnesota Charitable Gambling Control Board that they have approved the application for lawful gambling for the American Legion Post #113 located at 413 West Main Street, Marshall, Minnesota. All voted in favor of the motion.

Hess moved, Stunes seconded, the approval of the following plumbers licenses:
