<b>Subject:</b>	Repeal Emergency Ordinance No. 7-12-2022
<b>Background Information:</b>	<p>In July 2022 the City of Marshall enacted an emergency ordinance “on the sale of hemp derived THC food and beverages, which is set to expire on July 12, 2023. Minnesota Legislature passed and the Governor signed HF100/SF73 which establishes a regulatory framework for adult-use cannabis and lower potency hemp edibles.</p> <p>Ordinance 23-015 establishes an interim ordinance prohibiting any business, person, or entity from offering for retail sale, wholesale, testing, commercial growing, commercial cultivating, manufacturing, transporting, delivering, or commercial distribution of Cannabinoid Products. Other than lower potency products allowed in municipal liquor stores.</p>
