Department Report:

- On duty vehicle collision:
One of our officers was involved in an on-duty vehicle collision. The incident is currently under investigation by the Washington State Patrol. We expect to receive the completed investigation report within the coming weeks.
- Firearms:
Most of our officers have transitioned to their new firearms. Once all previously issued firearms have been turned in, we will move forward with options to get rid of them.
- City Ordinances:
We have started contacting residences that have unlicensed vehicles parked in the city right of way. This is intended to assist code enforcement with addressing violations that are occurring on properties.
- E-Scooters and E-Bikes:
The city has experienced an influx of e-scooters and e-bikes. A recent update to state law was put into effect for these items. Officers have been contacting riders throughout the city to provide education on safe operation and applicable rules of the road. The development of a city ordinance should be considered to provide clearer local regulations, promote safe operation, and help reduce the risk of preventable injuries.

Bear Festival:

- We will have additional officers on duty during Bear Festival this year. The event went very smoothly from the police department's perspective last year, and we do not anticipate any different this year.
- TraCs:
Washington State has implemented the new TraCS program to replace the previous Sector system. This program will be used for infractions, citations, collisions, and related reporting. Most of our officers have completed the TraCs training, and we have begun installing the new program on department computers.
