## RESOLUTION TO ADOPT FIRE MILLAGE BALLOT LANGUAGE

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Charter Township of Madison wishes to provide for replacing fire and ambulance equipment and housing of same; and

WHEREAS, townships may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Madison Charter Township wishes to renew the 0.9661 millage voted millage levied or replacing fire and ambulance equipment and housing of same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Board of Madison Charter Township, Lenawee County, approves the following millage ballot question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the August 6, 2024 election ballot:

Shall the previous voted millage in the Charter Township of Madison of 0.9661 mills (\$0.9661 per \$1,000 of taxable value) be renewed at 0.9661 mills (\$0.9661 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for 4 years, 2025 through 2028 inclusive, for the purpose of replacing fire and ambulance equipment and housing of same. This millage will raise an estimated \$257,134.15 in the first year the millage is levied.
