WHEREAS 2024 LENAWEE COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Madison Charter Township from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS adoption by the Madison Charter Township Board demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2024 LENAWEE COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MADISON CHARTER TOWNSHIP, MICHIGAN, THAT:

Section 1. In accordance with MCL 42.20 the Madison Charter Township Board adopts the 2024 LENAWEE COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN. While content related to Madison Charter Township may require revisions to meet the plan approval requirements, changes occurring after adoption will not require Madison Charter Township to re-adopt any further iterations of the plan. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this plan will require separate adoption resolutions.
