RE: Discussion and approval of 2025 Emergency Medical Services ALS First

Responder Agreement, Amendment 1

## **Background**

The Pinellas County Emergency Medical Services provides for the long-term direction and financial stability of the entire Emergency Medical Services System for Pinellas County through working with the First Responder agencies in providing and assisting in controlling costs.

The Department entered an ALSFR Agreement on October 1, 2024. This agreement allows for a 5 year renewal between the City of Madeira Beach and Pinellas County. Budget submissions will continue to be annual.

Pinellas County Emergency Medical Services agrees to, has funded and authorized the City of Madeira Beach, Madeira Beach Fire Department budget request of \$1,556,821 for FY25-26, this change is reflected in Appendix A of the Agreement along with all additional changes and revisions as outlined in Agreement's Amendment 1.

### **Fiscal Impact**

Fiscal impact is an increase of \$1,556,821 for FY25-26. The total of the agreed budget includes funds allocated for the Redingtons EMS Station.

## Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of the 2025 Emergency Medical Services ALS First Responder Agreement, Amendment 1 which is attached for review.
