#### **ORDINANCE NO. 678**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MADEIRA BEACH, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING TWO RESTRICTED AREAS IN THE GULF OF MEXICO, WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS FOR THE EXCLUSION OF POWER BOATS AND PROTECTION OF SWIMMERS.

WHEREAS, the City of Madeira Beach is concerned with the welfare and safety of both swimmers and boaters, and

WHEREAS, the public beaches within Madeira beach are extensively used by waders and swimmers, and

WHEREAS, the boating public is sometimes inconsiderate of the swimming public and threatens the safety of swimmers by high speed operations close to the shoreline.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF

COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF MADEIRA BEACH, FLORIDA as follows:

Section 1. The rectangular area of water, approximately 510 feet parallel to Archibald Memorial Beach and extending approximately 300 feet westward into the Gulf of Mexico, is hereby declared to be a Madeira Beach restricted area for the exclusive use of swimmers and surfers.

Section 2. The rectangular area of water, approximately 450 feet parallel to the County/City Access Park and extending approximately 300 feet westward into the Gulf of Mexico, is hereby declared to be a Madeira Beach restricted area for the exclusive use of swimmers and surfers.

Section 3. The City Manager is hereby directed to petition the Department of Natural Resources to designate the above described areas as "restricted areas" within the meaning of Florida Statutes Chapter 327, Section 327.46.

Section 4. The City Manager shall arrange to have the "restricted areas", when so designated, marked with buoys as prescribed in Florida Statutes, Chapter 327, Section 327.40.

of any size, jet ski or sailboat of more than 14 feet in length, shall be allowed to operate. Surfboards, sailboards, paddle boats, and sailboats of an acceptable size shall not operate in the swim area but shall be allowed to traverse the swim area to reach water outside the restricted area.

#### Dear Sir:

The City of Madeira Beach, has passed Ordinance No. 678 establishing two areas in the Gulf of Mexico, within the city limits for the exclusion of power boats and the protection of swimmers. (A copy of Ordinance No. 678 is enclosed.)

The specific location of these two areas is denoted on an enclosed chart. One water area is approximately 510 feet by 300 feet adjacent to and west of Archibald Memorial Beach which is legally defined as Tract 13-05, Part of Government Lots 1 and 2.

The other water area is approximately 450 feet by 300 feet adjacent to and west of Pinellas County/City Access Park which is legally defined as Tract 44/02, described by metes and bounds.

The City desires to have these areas designated "Restricted Areas" within the definition contained in Florida Statutes Section 327.46 for the purpose of providing safer swimming areas for the public. All power boats should be excluded except in the case of an emergency necessitating rescue craft.

To reiterate, the purpose of the restriction is to protect swimmers and surfers from power boats.

Seven buoy markers, approximately one hundred fifty feet apart, will be installed to deliniate the restricted area at Archibald Memorial Beach. Six buoy markers, approximately one hundred fifty feet apart, will be installed to deliniate the restricted area at County/City Access Park. A vertical diamond shape of international orange with a cross of the same color within it against a white center, without

qualifying explanation, shall be used to indicate a zone from which all vessels are excluded. The exact size of the buoy markers is not known at this time but it is intended to comply with the requirements of Chapter 16N-18, Florida Intercoastal Waterway Markers, Section 16N-18.02.

The City of Madeira Beach hereby assumes the responsibility for the purchase, placement, upkeep and eventual removal of the regulatory markers.

A copy of the public notice announcing a public hearing on Ordinance No. 678 is enclosed for your records.

It is estimated that the thirteen buoys installed by a local contractor will cost \$2,200.00. Upkeep of the markers is estimated at \$50.00 per year, per buoy.
