EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

CLEMIS has served Oakland County courts and public safety agencies for decades by providing a shared technology platform that allows fire departments and law enforcement agencies to access, share, and manage critical public safety information. The attached Participation Agreement authorizes the City of Madison Heights to continue participating in the Courts and Law Enforcement Management Information System (CLEMIS) under a newly established CLEMIS Authority. While the management of the system is transitioning from the Oakland County Information Technology Department to an independent intergovernmental authority, the services and functionality currently relied upon the City of Madison Heights police and fire departments will remain in place. The new structure is designed to ensure the continued operation and oversight of the CLEMIS system by the agencies that use it.

The Participation Agreement maintains existing protections related to data ownership, security, confidentiality, and CJIS compliance, while ensuring participating agencies retain ownership and access to their data. The CLEMIS Authority is governed by representatives from participating member agencies, and as a member, the City of Madison Heights will have representation on the Authority Board. This provides the City of Madison Heights with a voice in future decisions regarding the operation, services, and costs associated with the system. Approval of the Participation Agreement will allow the City of Madison Heights to remain an active partner in a regional public safety network while helping guide the future of a system that is essential to our police and fire operations.

RECOMMENDATION:

Police Chief Brent LeMerise recommends City Council approve the attached CLEMIS Participation Agreement.
