EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

- Michigan Public Act 390 of 1976, as amended
- Local (City & County) – State – Federal
- Governor / Michigan State Police EMHSD
- County EOC – SEOC – DHS / FEMA
- Private Sector / NGOs, VOADs, PNPs
- Emergency Operations Plan (EOP)
- Local EOP Support Plans
- National Incident Management System (NIMS) – Multi-Agency Coordination, Incident Command System (ICS)
- Declared State of Emergency / Disaster
- PA & IA, Hazard Mitigation Grants



UNDERSTAND HAZARDS AND THREATS

- Tornado, High Winds, Severe Thunderstorms
- Flooding
- Severe Winter Weather (Snow, Ice)
- Extreme Heat, Extreme Cold
- Public Health Emergency (Pandemic)
- Power Outage
- Fire (includes wildfires, conflagration)
- HAZMAT (Fixed Site, Transportation)
- Terrorism (CBRNE)
- Active Assailant / Mass Casualty Incident
- Cyber Attack



PHASES OR CYCLE; ACTION STEPS

- Preparedness, Prevention, Protection
- Mitigation
- Response (MHPD, MHFD, special teams, mutual aid)
- Recovery
- All-Hazards, specific hazards
- Have a Plan, have a Kit (supplies), have a Communication Plan (include staying informed), practice the plan (conduct drills)
- Shelter-in-Place vs Evacuation
- Warning Sirens, IPAWS / EAS / WEA
- Social Media
