Subject: Parks and Recreation Master Plan – Public Hearing and Adoption

Staff has been diligently working on the new 5-Year Parks and Recreation Master Plan throughout the 2025 calendar year. Unlike in previous years, when we engaged an outside consultant, this time the plan was developed entirely in-house. We believe this approach has resulted in a stronger, more relevant plan—one that better reflects the goals and priorities of our staff, City Council, and community members.

Since April, staff and members of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board have actively engaged the community through the following efforts:

- Attendance at six community events
- Publication of 12 social media posts
- Two targeted public engagement initiatives
- Two public hearings, including:
 - One focused on accessibility
 - o One reviewing engagement findings with the Advisory Board and City Council

In total, we gathered feedback from 822 individuals, and 26 additional community members attended our public meetings.

Recommended Actions:

Staff recommends that City Council take the following two actions at tonight's meeting:

- 1. **Hold a Public Hearing** to receive comments on the proposed Parks and Recreation Master Plan.
- 2. **Following the hearing, approve the resolution** adopting the Master Plan and authorizing staff to submit it to the Michigan Department of Natural Resources.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held in person at the Regular City Council Meeting on December 8, 2025, to provide an opportunity for all residents of the planning area to express opinions, ask questions, and discuss all aspects of the City of Madison Heights Parks and Recreation Master Plan, and

WHEREAS, the City of Madison Heights has developed the plan as a guideline for improving recreation and enhancing natural resource conservation for the City of Madison Heights, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED after the public hearing, the City Council of the City of Madison Heights hereby adopts the City of Madison Heights Parks and Recreation Master Plan for 2026-2030.
