How will Inside|Out enhance your community events?

"Home is where the Art is!" has been the slogan for the Madison Heights Arts Board since its creation in 2017. The statement rings true as the board has been responsible for bringing murals, events, and live performances to The Heights. The Board is credited with sponsoring three murals to Park Shelter Buildings in 2019, 2020, and 2022, in addition to multiple sidewalk murals. The Board hosts annual events such as Arts and Pride, Americans with Disabilities Pride, Trail Tunes, and the Arts Gala. The goal of these events is to bring residents together to celebrate something that bonds us all: ART!

Last year, with the support of the Arts Board, the City accepted a proposal to build an outdoor amphitheater at Civic Center Park, further enhancing artistic programming. This bandshell is dedicated to outdoor performances - from music, to dance, to theatre, to spoken word. Adding DIA Paintings around the walking path at Civic Center Park will enhance events by adding a unique flare to festivals and live performances. There are few places to enjoy the fresh air while admiring world-renowned paintings, live performances, stunning murals, and beautifully manicured rain gardens. Further, on a clear day, you can see the Detroit skyline from atop the hill at Civic Center Park. It reminds us we are part of a much larger art community.

- Rosie's Park a local hub of activity
