The State of Michigan requires EMS agencies to adopt an up-to-date mutual aid arrangement every five years.

In 2019, the City Council approved revisions to the 2012 Interlocal Agreement, creating the Oakway Mutual Aid Association and Mutual Aid Box Alarm System Division 3202 mutual aid agreement.

Attached for City Council review is the Interlocal Agreement between the political subdivision of the Citys of Birmingham, Farmington Hills, Ferndale, Madison Heights Heights, Rochester Hills, Royal Oak, Southfield, and the Townships of Independence, Waterford, and West Bloomfield.

Since its last adoption in 2019, the only change to the association is the addition of the Independence Township Fire Department to the group. No other language changes or edits have been made to the agreement.

Staff and I recommend that the City Council approve the Interlocal Agreement. I would be happy to address any questions or comments you may have.
