- Family-Owned and Family-Operated Sheetz was founded in 1952 by 18-year-old Bob Sheetz in Altoona, PA. The Sheetz family, now into its third generation, still owns and operates Sheetz today!
- Continuous Growth Sheetz currently operates more than 700 store locations across six states, including Pennsylvania, Ohio, North Carolina, Virginia, West Virginia and Maryland.
- Great Jobs Sheetz employs more than 25,000 employees, creating between 30-35 jobs each time a new store location opens. We offer competitive wages and great benefits – including medical/dental/vision and tuition reimbursement.
- What you Want, How You Want It and When You Want It Sheetz is open 24/7/365. Our stores offer touch screen ordering systems that let you customize your order exactly how you want it! Our locations also offer easily accessible gas pumps, a wide selection of snacks/beverages and seating areas that give you the chance to relax while you are visiting our locations.



Commitment to Total Customer Focus

- Focus on Safety to Employees and Customers Each of our stores is accessible, well-lit and monitored, 24/7, by camera surveillance. Additionally, our store teams are supported around the clock by our corporate security team which can be activated at any time to address issues at our locations. Sheetz works to build strong relationships with local police departments in every community where our stores operate.
- Advanced Technology Sheetz maintains 100 percent compliance with Federal and State regulations for its motor fuel storage systems. According to the FY 23 U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Office of Underground Storage Tanks Program annual report, the average compliance rate of our peers is below 60 percent.
- Commitment to Innovation Sheetz is committed to continual innovation and we have the track record to prove it. We were the first company in the restaurant/convenience store industry to use touch screen order points. We are leading on electric vehicle charging, too, with more than 100 stores with EV chargers and more coming online every month! As a company committed to innovation we are also developing our own proprietary chargers.

Helping Our Communities

- Local Donations Since 1952, Sheetz has been dedicated to supporting non-profit organizations that are making a difference in their communities. We focus on organizations that are involved in scholastic programs, youth sports and community activities/advancement. Sheetz fulfills hundreds of donation requests each month. In 2022, Sheetz donated more than \$1.6 million to local causes in the areas we serve.
- Sheetz For The Kidz Sheetz For The Kidz was created in 1992 by two Sheetz district managers who saw a need for an organization that would help kids have a brighter holiday season. Each year, our employees shop for, wrap, and present gifts to kids supporting 11,500 children last year! Additionally, each store presents a \$1,000 grant to a Feeding America food bank to support youth-related hunger programs. Food banks in the areas our stores serve use these funds for initiatives such as backpack programs, which ensure that children are not hungry when they're away from school.



Sheetz Gives Back

- Special Olympics Since 1991, Sheetz has partnered with Special Olympics. Today, we are a major partner of this amazing organization in each state where our stores operate. Donation boxes are available at our stores, 10 months out of each year, to collect money for Special Olympics. In addition, we donate funds to Special Olympics at each new store opening and provide food for athletes at events across our six states.
- Made-to-Share Each store participates in Made-to-Share and donates food every week to a Feeding America-affiliated food bank. Since this program was created in 2018, Sheetz has kept approximately 5 million lbs. of food out of landfills and into the hands of the people who need it. That total averages 1 million lbs. a food per year! We also make a donation to our food bank partner at new store openings.
- Active in Our Communities Sheetz employees are eager to find ways to help our major partners. Every year, our team members volunteer with Special Olympics for their summer/winter games and polar plunges. In 2023, Sheetz launched a partnership with the USO and a team from Dayton, OH visited Wright Patterson Air Force Base and volunteered their time assisting with events for active duty service members.
