- When may I start Brewing? You may not operate your brewery until we approve your Brewer's Notice (including all attachments) and your Brewer's Bond (if a bond is required under 27 CFR 25.91).
- When must I file a Brower's Notice? You must file this form:
  - To start business at your brewery premises;
  - To amend or supplement information you previously submitted or;
  - In connection with a new bond.
- Do I need to file any other documents with the Brower's Natice? You must file the stinchments this form requires. Also, we may require you to furnish any additional information we find necessary to protect revenue and insure collection of taxes.
- What happens if I do not complete this notice? We will return your notice to you for correction if it is not completed in accordance with these instructions or does not include all of the required information and documents. If you do not complete the notice you may not produce or nackaos beer.

Describe the entire tract of land by using directions and distances:

the land the brewery building sits on starts 100 feet south of Fairburn ave, to the NW corner of the building and continues 350 feet south on main st, to the SW comer of the building it extends 200 feet east of Main st, to the end of the rear parting lot, then 350 feet north to the other end of the rear parking tot and 200 feet west back to Main st.

Describe the brewery premises.

The building sits 1 hundred feet south of Fairburn Ave. on Main St. the brewery will be in the north west comer of the building on the bottom floor extending south for 40 feet and extending east for 75 feet within the building. The building extends another 300 feet south and 50 feet east, the building is multi story (3) with mixed retail/services and housing, there is a window in the brewery starting 2 feet from the NW corner and extends 8 feet to the south and 8 feet up. the front door is 30 feet south from the NW corner and is a double entry door, the rear door is 5 feet from the NE corner of the building and is 75 feet from the front door. building construction is steel frame with cement floors, the North wall is cinder block construction as is the south wall with metal facade on the west and east walls.

The Tavern/Pub area of the brewery will extend from in front of the bar for 20 feet south to the end of the atrium and will extent east from the brew house for 32 feet to include the bathroom and then 31 feet east from the eastern end of the bar to the back wall and 10 feet north to the storage room wall and 31 feet west to the end of the cooler/bar.

You must identify areas of the brewery which are accessible to the public and areas which are not.

Accessible areas include the bar, the atrium, the bathroom and the room opposite the storage room leading to the back door. non accessible areas include behind the bar, the brewhouse, and the cooler.

Describe security measures to be used to segregate public areas from non-public areas.

There will be an L shaped wall and a 48' solid wall that is behind barrels extending from the west wall 3 feet north of the front door going east for 12 feet to the support post and north from the post 10 feet to the edge of the bar. The 48' solid wall will be used to separate, and the barrels will be for looks. The eastern end of the bar will have a lockable swing door covering the 5 feet from the edge of the bar north to the southern edge of the cooler.

Describe in detail the method to be used for measuring beer for the purpose of tax determination. Identify the tanks which will periodically contain tax-determined beer, and any other areas where tax-determined beer will be.

glasses on the fermenter/oright tanks and will be PM'd monthly with a predetermined amount of non beer fluid for accuracy then transferred to kegs weighed on calibrated scales that will be PM'd monthly using a calibrated weight, the tax determined beer will be stored in the cooler for purposes of serving from taps and will be the tax-determined area.

the front and side hallway access door to the elevator and rear doors will be locked during officiosed hours, all taps will have tap locks, all fermenters will have valve locks and all kegs will be stored in the cooler with a pad locked door.
