SUBJECT: **Resolution No. 84-R-2024** – A Resolution of the Town of Mead, Colorado,

Approving an Agreement by and between the Town of Mead, Colorado, and Sanborn Reservoir and Ditch Company for the Grant of a Revocable License

for a Concrete Pedestrian Trail and Ditch Crossing

#### **SUMMARY**

The SH66 Pedestrian Crossing project will construct an underpass under SH 66 and a concrete pedestrian trail on the west side of CR 7 both north and south of the underpass. South of SH 66, the trail will be constructed within three overlapping easements, including two easements owned by Sanborn Reservoir and Ditch Company. The Town desires to enter into an agreement with Sanborn Reservoir and Ditch Company for the grant of a revocable license to construct, install, operate, use, inspect, maintain, repair, survey, and replace the trail as needed in the easement area.

A separate agreement with the other easement holder, Longs Peak Water District, was presented to and passed by the Board on August 26, 2024, Resolution No. 64-R-2024.

## FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

## STAFF RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUIRED

Staff recommends the Board of Trustees approve the Resolution and agreement between the Town of Mead, Colorado, and Sanborn Reservoir and Ditch Company, granting a license for a Concrete Pedestrian Trail and Ditch Crossing.
