Housing to Redmond Supportive Housing for A Regional Coalition for Housing (ARCH)

Summary

The City of Medina became a member of A Regional Coalition for Housing (ARCH) in 1999. The City Council is required by the ARCH Interlocal Agreement to review and approve the Annual Administrative Budget and Work Plan.

On March 8, 2010, the City Council approved the Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement as part of the Consent Agenda.

On April 10, 2023, the City Council approved the ARCH Work Program and Budget, which allocated funding for eight projects, including the Kenmore Support Housing project.

Following the Executive Board's approval of the funding recommendation for the Redmond Supportive Housing project, detailed in the memo dated July 19, 2024 (see **Attachment 1**), ARCH is now requesting to reallocate previously approved funds for Plymouth Housing to support the development of this project at a new location.
