Subject: 2021-2023 Planning Commission Work Plan

<u>Summary</u> Every year, in collaboration with Planning Commission and staff, the City Council adopts a work plan that identifies a set of issues for Planning Commission to advise Council on. To provide a comprehensive snapshot, the work plan includes tasks that are currently being worked on, the subsequent issues that will be discussed, and the timing of the City's next mandated updates. Where it makes sense, as Planning Commission works through the plan, related and overlapped topics will be combined to better inform the synthesis of analysis or code update.

Although adopted yearly, the work plan should be thought of as a dynamic document that can and will be changed as needed if priorities shift or new legislation requires action by the city.
