Summary

Earlier this year, the Lake Lane Dock was damaged by fire and resulted in a full closure. The damage was extensive and needs substructure repairs. This type of over-the-water construction requires a Hydraulic Permit (HPA) issued by the WDFW. The HPA permit was issued on July 17, 2026.

This contract provides for the removal, disposal, and in-kind replacement of fire damaged elements at the City's Lake Lane Dock. Work will also include securing the work site, pedestrian traffic control, and site cleanup.
