Roanoke Park Playground Replacement

- Work to replace and upgrade the aging playground at Roanoke Park is progressing.
- Updates were made to enhance safety, accessibility, and play experiences for children of all ages.
- The park has been busy the last three weeks as crews started installing the poured-in-place accessible play surfacing and formed the picnic pad, ADA parking stall, and parking curbing.
- In the coming weeks, the team will finish the surfacing and concrete work, install furnishings and signage, and restore the lawn areas that were disturbed during construction.

Aubrey Davis Trail Safety Improvements

- This project providing safer pedestrian crossings, improved visibility, traffic calming, and enhanced wayfinding to make the trail safer for users is almost complete!
- Last week, the City's contractor installed supplemental signage to increase safety of trail users.
- The crew will return in the coming weeks to complete the remaining punch list items.
- Project completion is anticipated by the end of July.





King County Sewerline Upgrade

- Work on the King County North Mercer Enatai Sewer Upgrade project continues. This work upgrades four miles of sewer pipeline from the 1970's that are aging and reaching capacity.
- Beginning today, final paving is taking place on 81st Ave S.E. (just north of North Mercer Way) and on North Mercer Way between 81st Ave S.E. and Island Crest Way. During this work, pedestrian, bike, and vehicle detours will be in place around the work area.
