Mostly Music in the Park

- We had **six weeks** of FANTASTIC concerts at Mercerdale Park this summer!
- Music ranged from a Beatles tribute to 80's New Wave, and crowds grew estimated between 400 – 600.

Summer Events

- **Shakespeare in the Park** held 15 shows at Luther Burbank Park in July/August, with crowds reaching up to **300 attendees!** Special thanks to the Mercer Island Community Fund for their sponsorship, along with King County 4Culture.
- **Juneteenth** was celebrated in Mercerdale Park with the partnership of the MIHS Black Student Union. It was a great day, with music from Island resident, Simon Okelo and his band.
- **Pride in the Park** was held before the August 7th Mostly Music in the Park. We had an amazing turn out of attendees, who enjoyed hands-on art activities hosted by the Mercer Island Visual Arts League, plus a host of community booths offering resources and connection opportunities.





Summer Camp Success

- Recreation staff experienced a **strong summer camp season**, teaming up with local organizations to offer a wide variety of camps for the community.
- This year's summer camps saw more than **1,300 kids** participating in **10 different camps** hosted at the MICEC and multiple parks across the island.
- We welcomed 5 returning camp partners and introduced five new ones. Our returning LEGO Camp experienced remarkable growth, nearly doubling from **38 participants last year to 89 this summer**.



Mid-Autumn Festival

- On Sunday October 5, the Mercer Island Chinese Association partnered with the City to bring back the Mid-Autumn Festival to the MICEC.
- The event featured cultural performances, hands-on workshops, traditional games, and culinary traditions.
- With approximately 1,000 in attendance, it was a wonderful day filled with celebration and connection.
- City staff are grateful for this meaningful community partnership that showcases the rich cultural diversity of Mercer Island!




